




with the academic world. Worapoj was a full-time lecturer at the Faculty of Sociology and Anthropology, Thammasat University and has been conducting research with leading research think-tanks in Thailand such as Thailand Development Research Institute (TDRI)



and Thailand Research Fund (TRF). Pokpong was an assistant professor at the Faculty of Economics, Thammasat University and has been working as a researcher, knowledge management and public communication director and advisor, and journalist. He is currently a co-founder, CEO and MD of The 101 Percent, Co., Ltd., a creative knowledge media company.

Apart from its focus on non-fiction book, BOOKSCAPE has always been working on 'creating' and 'communicating' various books and topics regarding 'children and family.'


